

iPass 3.5.1 Release Notes for Android

VERSION 1.0, AUGUST 2016

New Features and Enhancements

iPass 3.5.1 for Android added the following features:

- Full integration with iPass SmartConnect SDK
- Auto connect Enhancements:
 - The client cannot auto connect to GIS networks with invalid credentials. Auto connect will continue to ask for valid credentials and proceed to attempt to connect to available free networks.
 - Auto connect attempts should be delayed for 20 minutes if user interrupts auto connect. The interval will be reset after resuming to on screen state from off screen.
- New FHIS type was created to support HTTP definitions
- Branded iPass Android clients can activate with ACA

System Requirements

iPass 3.5.1 for Android has the following requirements:

- A Wi-Fi capable device running Android OS 2.3 or later
- A screen with HVGA or higher resolution
- Obtaining the app via the Android Market, a private market, web sites, or email
- Users need an iPass account in order for the service to function. In addition, the user must be connected to the Internet (by Wi-Fi or 3G network) to activate

Supported Languages

iPass is available in English, Simplified Chinese, Traditional Chinese, Dutch, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Brazilian Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, and Thai.

Resolved Issues

Issue ID	Description
OMA-113	Licensee agreement and Privacy Policy file names are hardcoded for branded clients and not read from Resources files.
OMA-518	Autoconnect requires changing credentials if initial authentication attempt has failed.
OMA-522	Current behavior is: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ If there is any authmethod that has probe = 0, client will auto connect.▪ The failover logic for auto connect will ignore all auth records with probe = 1.▪ For manual connect, ignore probe value.▪ A response of authmethod = custom, probe = 1 is invalid.
OMA-555	Brazilian Portuguese welcome screen promotional text and dots no longer overlapping on Samsung SII.
OMA-561	There is a very brief delay as the Webview loads up; a small loading bar is now at the bottom of the Terms and Conditions dialog.
OMA-562	"iPass.com" now showing in proper iPass colors in Terms of Use page.
OMA-573	Android no longer connecting to secured network without network key.
OMA-575	iPass Android 3.5.0 has the wrong format (.jpeg instead of .png) splash screen causing branded clients to fail.
OMA-647	T&C on older android devices 3.x and 2.x is not shown correctly.
OMA-653	Cannot initialize LocaleData for locale en.
OMA-639	Client crashes when RtnApi.so is not loaded.
OMA-596	The logs zip file—formerly named "iPass.zip"—has been renamed "logs.zip".

Known Limitations

Issue ID	Description
OMA-419	On some devices—especially among several Samsung devices—the network landing page is launched automatically, without user prompt, making user experience less friendly.
OMA-370	This is an inconsistent issue: one-click activation fails on first attempt and is successful on second attempt. After clicking on the email link and downloading the client from store and client launches and doesn't proceed for activation. Its stays in "get started" wizard. Referrer code is not being passed.

Known Issues

iPass 3.5.1 for Android has the following known issues:

Issue ID	Description
116605	Occasionally, Android 4.0 devices may loop in the presence of access points with a non-effective DHCP server. When this occurs, a connection attempt can continue for up to 2 minutes while giving “Connecting” message. The user can either disconnect from the malfunctioning network or initiate a connection to another available network. Device connectivity is not disrupted during these events.
OMA-363	6.0 OS devices, if WiFi is connected to Personal network from native WiFi manager, you will be unable to switch the connection to iPass network.

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
