



iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS Release Notes

These release notes contain the latest news and information about iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS, including:

Features

iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS has the following new features:

- Redesigned **User Interface**
- **Usage Meter** that shows Wi-Fi and cellular data usage.
- **Cellular Data Usage Alerts** that warn users as they approach their monthly limit when the app is running in the foreground.
- **Default Mode** with access to the Usage Meter and Hotspot Finder for users who have not activated.
- **Authentication Format** account configuration for Administrators.
- **Authentication Format Override** for each Network Directory.
- **Activation Instructions** for end users available in the Open Mobile Portal.
- **Additional Language Support:** Spanish, Italian, Korean, and Japanese.

Technical Requirements

iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS requires an iOS device that supports multitasking (iPhone 3GS or later, iPod touch 3rd generation or later, or any iPad) running iOS 4.x or higher and an iPass account.

Supported Languages

iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS is available in the following languages:

Resolved Issues

The following issues have been resolved for iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS:

Issue ID	Description
111777	In German, "Do not show this message again" is no longer slightly truncated.

Known Limitations

iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS has the following limitations:

Issue ID	Description
114231	If a network directory is larger than 128 KB, iOS will no longer allow Open Mobile to log in to captive networks. Open Mobile has a filter to keep the network directory under this limit.
113773	On a first-generation iPad, Open Mobile may crash due to low memory.
113673	If a user sending logs decides to cancel and save a draft of the email, then minimizes Open Mobile and tries to restart it, Open Mobile will crash. This is a limitation of iOS common to other apps .
n/a	Cellular data usage alerts will only work when the app is running in the foreground due to a limitation in iOS.
n/a	Users can only authenticate with the iPass Open Mobile app (they still have to connect through the iOS Wi-Fi Settings).

Known Issues

The following issues are known for iPass Open Mobile 2.0 for iOS:

Issue ID	Description
113418	The Usage Meter will report slightly higher cellular data usage than the iOS native Settings app.
112438	If an umlaut character (such as ü or ö) is entered into the PIN field when activating Open Mobile and then Done is tapped, Open Mobile will crash.
111306	If there is no Internet connection and the user tries to download a profile or update the directory, the error message only tells the user that there was a failure without indicating the problem (an Internet connection is required).
