# Open Mobile 2.0.0 for Windows Phone Release Notes

These release notes contain the latest news and information about Open Mobile 2.0.0 for Windows Phone.

#### **New Features and Enhancements**

#### Password Assistance

Open Mobile will verify a user's saved credentials, ensuring they have valid credentials before trying to connect with Open Mobile.

#### Connectivity Enhancements

Open Mobile will help streamline the login process by passing its network data to the Windows Phone OS and supporting OS-initiated notifications that allow users to enter their account information (if an iPass network is detected).

## **System Requirements**

- Wi-Fi capable Windows 8.1 phone.
- Users need an iPass account in order for the service to function. In addition, the user must be connected to the Internet, have an Activation Code, and (if necessary) a PIN to activate Open Mobile.

## **Supported Languages**

■ English, French, German, Japanese, and Spanish.

### **Resolved Issues**

Issue ID	Description
127151	Users can successfully switch profiles and then connect to a GIS network (even if they perform the switch after activating Open Mobile).



## **Known Limitations**

Issue ID	Description
122640	It is possible that not all Wi-Fi networks will allow a user to log off. Because of this, using the Open Mobile log off option may not result in an actual log off.

# **Known Issues**

Issue ID	Description
123700	In some instances, the correct network name may not be properly displayed on the dashboard. A user can refresh their network list to fix the problem. (Please note that refreshing the network list may slow down certain tasks on Open Mobile.)
