

Open Mobile Connection Behavior

VERSION 2.0, AUGUST 2012

This matrix describes the expected connection behavior of Open Mobile across five network types: iPass/GIS, OpenAccess, non-iPass, open network (such as personal hotspots) and Gogo Inflight.

The table entries are as follows:

- **No browser needed:** No browser is required for login. User can log in using standard Open Mobile functionality (by the credentials entry dialog).
- **Integrated browser login:** Open Mobile presents its integrated browser window for user login.
- **OS launches browser:** The device operating system launches the device browser for user login
- **Integrated browser login + CAPTCHA:** Open Mobile launches its integrated browser window for user login, and requires an additional CAPTCHA entry to complete. (CAPTCHA stands for *Completely Automated Public Turing test to tell Computers and Humans Apart*. In the test, a text string is presented to the user that would be difficult for an automated system to interpret. The user must enter the textual characters shown in the string exactly as presented, which helps to ensure that the login is not being performed by an automated system.)
- **Not applicable:** The specified network type is not supported by the device.
