

Open Mobile 2.0.0 for Windows Phone Release Notes

VERSION 1.0, AUGUST 2014

These release notes contain the latest news and information about Open Mobile 2.0.0 for Windows Phone.

New Features and Enhancements

- **Password Assistance**
 - Open Mobile will verify a user's saved credentials, ensuring they have valid credentials before trying to connect with Open Mobile.
- **Connectivity Enhancements**
 - Open Mobile will help streamline the login process by passing its network data to the Windows Phone OS and supporting OS-initiated notifications that allow users to enter their account information (if an iPass network is detected).

System Requirements

- Wi-Fi capable Windows 8.1 phone.
- Users need an iPass account in order for the service to function. In addition, the user must be connected to the Internet, have an Activation Code, and (if necessary) a PIN to activate Open Mobile.

Supported Languages

- English, French, German, Japanese, and Spanish.

Resolved Issues

Issue ID	Description
127151	Users can successfully switch profiles and then connect to a GIS network (even if they perform the switch after activating Open Mobile).



Known Limitations

Issue ID	Description
122640	It is possible that not all Wi-Fi networks will allow a user to log off. Because of this, using the Open Mobile log off option may not result in an actual log off.

Known Issues

Issue ID	Description
123700	In some instances, the correct network name may not be properly displayed on the dashboard. A user can refresh their network list to fix the problem. (Please note that refreshing the network list may slow down certain tasks on Open Mobile.)
