



Open Mobile Portal 2.3 Release Notes

These release notes contain the latest news about Open Mobile Portal 2.3, including:

New Features and Enhancements

Open Mobile Portal 2.3 includes these new features and enhancements:

- **Open Mobile Lite Support:** The Portal now supports the creation of Open Mobile Lite client profiles. Open Mobile Lite is a simplified version of the Open Mobile 2.1 for Windows client.
- **Connect Before Logon:** Windows clients can now enable the new Connect Before Logon feature, which permits a network connection before logon to the local Windows domain.
- **iPassConnect Conversion:** Enterprises currently using iPassConnect can convert to an Open Mobile account using a simple form available on the Open Mobile Portal by invitation.
- **User Activity Report:** The new User Activity Report consolidates user and device activity into a single report, providing a more comprehensive view of Open Mobile user activity. The report will be available for download to Excel format.

Technical Requirements

Using the iPass Open Mobile Portal requires an Internet connection and one of the following browsers, with both JavaScript and Adobe Flash Player 10 enabled:

- Internet Explorer version 7 or later.
- Mozilla Firefox version 3 or later.

Resolved Issue

The following issue has been resolved for this release of the Open Mobile Portal:



Issue ID	Description
114705	The breadcrumbs on the Accounts pages will now correctly show the complete trail taken to get to the current page, instead of showing pages at the same hierarchical level.

Known Issues

The following issues are known for this release of the Open Mobile Portal:

Issue ID	Description
114779	For the User Activity report, downloaded data in Excel format will return an error message if the data contains more than 65,535 records.
114723	On the Manage Assignments page, when searching for a company and a space is included after the Company ID, the search will return 'Company Not Found.'
114393	For Android 2.2 profiles, the iPass default brand is erroneously shown in the Brands page when a profile is migrated from Android 2.1 to Android 2.2.
114339	Brand sharing allows a brand to be shared with to a child customer, even though the service package has not been assigned to the child company.
114337	For Android client versions earlier than 2.0.0, Publish to Test fails for a profile which has been created from another profile (by copying or editing) with a brand configured.
114282	The font will appear very large in the emailed Trial and Pilot agreements.
114114	After adding new privileges to a Role, they may not show up correctly on the Roles page. Clear the browser cache in order to display them correctly.
114040	Accounts can be saved without entering an authentication format. If so, then the client will try to authenticate with an empty format (and fail).
113825	The grid on the Manage Assignments page may show inconsistently after clicking Cancel and reloading the page.
113766	The first service package published by a partner admin becomes the default package, without giving any warning.
113755	After creating a brand as part of a service package, and deleting the platforms to which that brand was assigned, and then attempting to create a new brand with the same name as an old one, the Portal will report that the brand name is already in use even if the brand is no longer visible in the list of brands.
113731	In the live branding preview, the Application Title element is labeled Application Name .
113485	In the live branding preview, during brand creation, the default title text changes if the software version is created.
113213	In Windows 1.4.x clients, the same message is configured for all required endpoint applications. If this client is migrated to Windows 2.x, this message will be used as the default for all required applications. This can result in a confusing user experience as the same message is displayed multiple times. When migrating from 1.4.x clients, make sure to configure different messages for each required application.
111125	For the Mac installer, the installer logo is not displayed correctly in the Portal preview.
107283	Use of some foreign-language characters (for example, å, ä or ö) in a profile name will lead to a "corrupt profile" error when the profile is installed.
107225	Branding live preview does not show changes to the application bar.
107144	Flash is required for use of the Portal; however, on some browsers, if Flash is not installed, no warning message is displayed to the user.
105232	If the user is on the Export Data report when the Portal times out, it is still possible to download the report by clicking the download link.
